- Create a price trend analysis for a LuSE-listed stock over six months. Discuss how market inefficiencies can be leveraged for better entry points.

Objective: Learn how to balance dividend income and capital appreciation in your portfolio.

 - Evaluating dividend sustainability and profit allocation policies
 - Identifying reinvestment opportunities in emerging industries
- **Case Study: Dividend vs. Reinvestment Strategy**
 - Compare companies that focus on dividends vs. those reinvesting profits
